In order to progress into the Social Work major, students must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 in this specified curriculum. To obtain full progression, which occurs prior to the senior year, students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average with a "C" or better in Social Work 2000, 2050, and all junior year social work courses; receive a satisfactory field practice evaluation.
