

**College of Business Administration General Education Recommendations
For 13 Community Colleges in Tennessee****

Communicating through Writing—3 courses

English 101 (English Composition I)

English 102 (English Composition II)

The WC requirement is satisfied by taking English 255 or 295 (or honors equivalents).

Communicating Orally—1 course

The OC requirement is satisfied by taking Communication Studies 210 or 240 (or honors equivalents).

Arts & Humanities—2 courses

The arts and humanities requirement is satisfied by taking any two courses from UTK's approved general education list.

Social Sciences—2 courses

Students must complete Economics 201 (Principles of Economics) and one other social sciences course from UTK's approved general education list.

Cultures & Civilizations—3 courses

Students must complete an intermediate foreign language sequence or the equivalent intensive course (or demonstrate competency on a departmental placement or proficiency exam or by AP or CLEP credit). The College of Business Administration also requires one non-US history course chosen from Africana Studies 235, 236; Asian Studies 101, 102; History 241, 242, 247, 248, 255, 256, 261, 262, 267, 268; Latin American Studies 251, 252; Medieval Studies 201, 202. NOTE: The non-US History requirement is specific to the College of Business Administration and is not part of UTK's general education requirements.

Natural Sciences—2 courses

The natural sciences requirement is satisfied by taking any two courses from UTK's approved general education list (at least one course must have a laboratory).

Quantitative Reasoning—2 courses

Math 123 (Finite Mathematics) and 125 (Basic Calculus) **OR**

Math 141 (Calculus I) and 142 (Calculus II)

Ethics—1 course

Students must complete Philosophy 243, 244, or 443. NOTE: The ethics requirement is specific to the College of Business Administration and is not part of UTK's general education requirement.

**To be admitted to a major, students must earn a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA (3.0 for accounting majors) in the eight pre-business core courses (Math 123-125 or 141-142, Accounting 200, Communication Studies 210 or 240, Economics 201, English 255 or 295, Statistics 201, and Business Administration 201) prior to completion of 75 total hours of coursework.
